We now sell most lambs off the farm but also enjoy showcasing them at sales in the spring, we've been fortunate to sell at the Main Event, Black & White and the Corporation lamb sales.

When starting, we had a goal in mind to always offer quality lambs over quantity of lambs. We may be a small-scale operation with our 30 ewes, but with years of hard work, research and finding the right network and resources, we've been able to see success through better genetics, understanding of feeding and exercise programs needed and helping provide knowledge and support to our customers.

We have had multiple county, district & jackpot winners and have even hung a couple of banners on the state level. We love it when the exhibitors reach big goals with their lambs, but seeing a smile on their face, even if they didn't win, is what keeps us going.
